Pre-Competition

- Meet with all invested parties to complete a schedule of events
- Gather materials and begin designing flyers
- Create a posting campaign schedule
- Practice week of monitoring recycling and tracking weights

SPRING Competition

Post flyers

- Send emails
- Partner with professors for events
- Weekly social media posts and activities
- Track weights based on decided system for competition
- Game Day Competition

SPRING Post-Competition

- Continue communicating with students and share results to campus
- End of Competition

 and changes needed for

- Purchase a rolling weighing scale to track & Weigh recyclables

- Partner with organizations & departments

- Recruit participants
- Assist with event management
- Monitor recycle bins

CAMPUS RACE TO ZERO WASTE: GAME DAY

PRE-GAME PLANNING

- Find volunteers and donations (for prizes)
- Choose 1-2 basketball themed recycle games
- Decide if waste weighing occurs during/after game
 - Choose smaller and measure at end
 - Choose larger and measure several times
- Work with custodial staff to set aside recycling and trash at game








AT THE GAME

- Set up signage, tables and games
- Ensure trash and recycling is pulled and stored throughout the game
- Measure recycling & trash at end of game
- Calculate diversion rates & enter results

THE RESULTS



- Students involved/invested in recycling efforts
- Showed university commitment to recycling
- Completed the season and placed, even amid the COVID-19 Pandemic

Words of Advice

- Recruit volunteers and helpers early and become GOOD friends with your custodial crew.
- Create a running schedule on a platform such as Google Docs, of all activities, events and tasks to do pre- and post-competition.
- Early on, create and practice a way to monitor and weigh your recycling for the entire campus or a specific area.
