Car Count since opening new facility in February 2025 – <u>15,954</u>

From January 1, 2023 to present, the facility has collected:

- * 330 tons of cardboard
- * 104 tons of PET #1 (plastic water bottles)
- * 53 tons of aluminum
- * 49 tons of crushed glass
