

Camera Program

- In 2023 LDWF was given a \$50,000 grant by the Keep Louisiana Beautiful Foundation so that new camera equipment could be purchased.
- With that money the following equipment was purchased for the program.
 - Thirty one cell cameras (Vosker).
 - Eight Axis pinhole cameras.
 - Six Axis security cameras.
 - One Axis dome camera.
 - Camera hardware. le, batteries, power cords, etc.
- The Axis cameras had to be retrofitted so that they could be operated off DC power and also store the needed footage of the violations.
- This equipment was distributed throughout the state to each Region office.
- Each Region has one Agent assigned to the Litter Task
 Force and are tasked with utilizing this equipment to work
 litter enforcement sites with his/her fellow Agents.

The Reconyx MS8 and MS7 cameras require Lithium batteries to operate correctly, but they can take several thousand pictures on one set of batteries. They require a smart phone and app, link to the app is provided, to access the camera setting, arm the camera and access the images. The phone will connect to the camera via Bluetooth for the settings and via Wi-Fi to download pictures. The MS8 camera is more of a game camera and the MS7 is set up as an LPR camera, they look identical, but the internal settings are different. We have some utility pedestal housings that the cameras can be mounted in.

The pole camera box offers real time streaming and records internally so you can playback and download your videos. The camera has PTZ controls, auto focus, and auto day/night switching. When placing the camera, you will need to consider power availability and cellular service at your target location. We have Verizon, AT&T, and T-Mobile units. There is a vented sticker hiding the camera that you will need to zoom past so try not to deploy the camera too close to your target.
