







NATURAL ASSET

- RECREATION INDUSTRY
 ON TVA LAKES HAS










Total Pounds of Trash Removed by Year

Tennessee River: Kentucky Lake




PIMPLEBACK

Tennessee River: Fort Loudoun Lake, Kentucky Lake (live specimen found)



- Cost to treat 1,000 gals of wastewater: \$10 = \$.01/gal
- Average mussel can filter ~ 10 gallons/day
- Lifespan of some mussel species: 100 years
- 10 gals/day x 36500 days) = 365,000 gals filtered
- $365,000 \text{ gals } \times 0.01 \text{ } /\text{gal} = \$3,650 \text{ in a lifetime}$
- For 50-year lifespan = \$1,825
- So, the loss of 1 billion mussels = loss of \$1,825,000,000,000 = \$1.825 trillion
- World economy last year \sim \$100 trillion
