







- 1,408 events in 64 Parishes 85% inc.
- Approx. 27,000 volunteers 42% inc.
- 514 tons of litter removed 48% inc.
- 1,204 trees planted 30% inc.
- 16,503 bottles and cans recycled 18% inc.
- 183 K-12 schools participated 154% inc.
- 74.4M impressions from campaign 284% inc.







Educating Motorist: OMV Partnership





OMV:

- Litter prevention banners in all OMVs.
- Three litter prevention questions on the State's official driving test.

Schools:

- Driving academies are required to provide 6 minutes of litter education.
- A roadside litter prevention video shown at driving academies.

Educating Motorists: Put the Brakes on Litter





50 participating LADA dealerships Over 13,000 kits distributed

Car Litter Prevention Kits:

- A disposable car litter bag.
- Litter prevention tips.
- A pocket ashtray for cigarette disposal.
- A car cupholder coaster with the litter hotline number for reporting.

Increasing Litter Enforcement





- ACT 67 State Park Rangers to enforce litter laws.
- Re-established the littering reporting hotline to report illegal dumping and simple littering.
- Surveillance cameras training and grants.
- Hired enforcement specialists and enforcement park ranger.
- Last year, KLB and WLF handled 875 litter reporting calls from the hotline.
